

**Professor Ryan Goodman (Harvard) joins NYU Law School permanent faculty in Fall 2009**

Professor Ryan Goodman joins NYU Law School permanent faculty in Fall 2009. He will also be an associated member of the Department of Sociology and an affiliated member of the Department of Politics at NYU.

Ryan Goodman is currently the Rita E. Hauser Professor of Human Rights and Humanitarian Law and Director of the Human Rights Program at Harvard Law School. A leading academic in the areas of international human rights law, public international law, and international relations, Professor Goodman utilizes his theoretical depth in the social sciences to yield important insights for the design of international law and institutions. A productive and multi-faceted scholar, he has published many articles including "Humanitarian Intervention and Pretexts for War" (*American Journal of International Law*, 2006) and "How to Influence States: Socialization and International Human Rights Law" (*Duke Law Journal*, 2004) (with Derek Jinks). He has also co-authored several books, two of which are forthcoming: *Socializing States: Promoting Human Rights through International Law* (Oxford University Press) (with Derek Jinks) and *International Humanitarian Law* (Oxford University Press) (with Derek Jinks and Michael Schmitt). These books make significant contributions to the evaluation of human rights treaties, and to thinking about international law more generally.

Prior to joining the Harvard Law School faculty, Ryan Goodman clerked for Judge Stephen Reinhardt of the U.S. Court of Appeals for the Ninth Circuit. He has worked at the U.S. Department of State, the International Criminal Tribunal for the former Yugoslavia, and nongovernmental organizations in India, South Africa, Switzerland, Thailand, and the United States. He is also a member of the Board of Editors of the *American Journal of International Law*. He received his J.D. from Yale Law School, where he served as an articles editor of the *Yale Law Journal*, and a Ph.D. in Sociology from Yale University.
