Ariel Colonomos holds degrees from the University of Paris-Dauphine (business and administration), the University of Paris X (philosophy) and a Ph.D. in political science from the Institut d'Etudes Politiques de Paris (IEP). He is currently Senior Research Fellow at the National Centre for Scientific Research (CNRS), member of the Centre for International Studies and Research (CERI) and teaches at Sciences Po Paris. Dr. Colonomos has authored several publications focusing on the emergence of norms in the post-cold war era and on the role of moral entrepreneurs, including a recent study on the preventive use of force and its justification.

Other books authored by Ariel Colonomos include: *Moralizing International Relations: Called to Account* (2008) and *Eglises en réseaux - Trajectoires politiques entre Europe et Amérique* (2000).
